Bayles Lake Homeowner's Association (BLHOA) policy is not to turn any water off or on without the resident being present. BLHOA is not responsible for any water leaks or water damage to your home.

Homeowners are encouraged to shut off water line service to their house before leaving the premises. This is especially important during winter months when exterior and interior pipes can be susceptible to freezing; although, other plumbing and water line problems can and do occur at any time.

Should a water line break or water leak develop while homeowner / resident is absent, and the water line has not been shut off, the homeowner will be charged a service call fee of \$50 plus all expenses incurred by BLHOA to remedy the problem.
